### WHAT YOU NEED TO APPLY

Applicants to the MSc programme require a bachelor's degree with a minimum of 60 credit points (ECTS) in sport science, psychology, research methodology, or a combination of these subjects. # **GO ABROAD**

Make the most of your degree by gaining international and intercultural experience, while expanding your professional network. Study abroad or obtain on-the-job training, by pursuing one of three optional programmes:

### **DOUBLE-DEGREE PROGRAMME**

Each year, six of our students are nominated to take part in an academic exchange with our partner, the University of Thessaly in Trikala, Greece. Candidates are selected during the first semester, based on students' academic suitability and their personal study motivation to study abroad. Leipzig University-based student nominees will spend their third semester enrolled at the University of Thessaly, while University of Thessaly-based students will study in Leipzig during their second semester. A degree will be issued by both universities upon graduation.

#### SELF-ORGANISED
